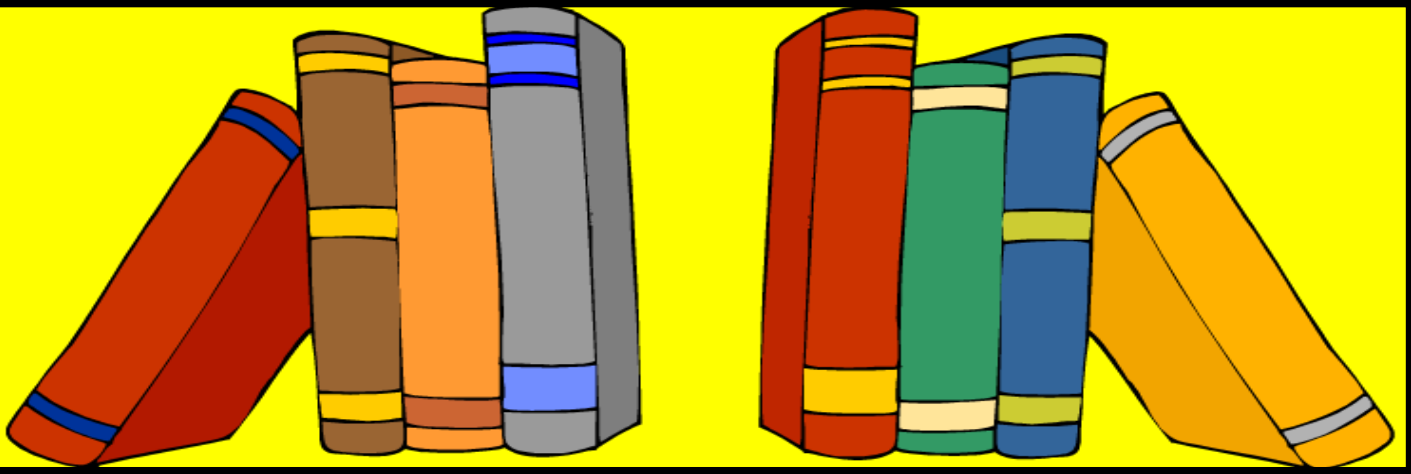

All Carteret County 6th – 12th graders, please consider becoming a Shelf Reader Volunteer at Carteret County Public Library (CCPL)! We need your help! The library staff is currently very busy “reading” the shelves to check for ownership, proper alphabetical sequencing, proper Dewey Decimal numerical sequencing, and the condition of all the books in our collections. (Each book has to be considered individually, so that’s a great deal of checking!)

In addition, the staff is designing games, writing and recording book reviews, collecting information, and adding to our web presence. All of these tasks require careful attention, hours and hours of manpower and many young and innovative minds. The staff is hoping that many of you will find the time and desire to serve the community through your library by becoming a Shelf Reader Volunteer and helping with these tasks as well!

If you are interested, on Saturday, October 12th, Shelf Readers will hold an organizational meeting in the Young Adult section of CCPL in Beaufort at 1702 Live Oak Street from 10:00 – 11:30. Lunch will be provided. Following training, a commitment of every other Saturday for an hour and a half a day would be ideal, though more time would be gratefully accepted.
