## ART EXHIBITS

**Beaufort:** The Gallery Wall at the Carteret County Public Library in Beaufort will feature a new series of paintings by Sally Anger called, *The Pale Blue Dot*. *The Pale Blue Dot* show is inspired by Carl Sagan's description of the earth as seen from the Voyager 1 space probe from 3.7 billion miles away, just as it was about to leave our Solar System. In it the Earth's apparent size is less than a pixel, our planet appears as a tiny dot against the vastness of space.

Beaufort artist Sally Anger, known for her large paintings of faces, was inspired by this concept to create a series of paintings inspired by our planet. Some of the canvases are round, and have abstracted images of the earth. Others are inspired by the concept of "flow" – the flowing of water, of colors, of ideas, of emotions, of the planets through space and ultimately the flow of life through time. Sally Anger grew up in the coastal town of Beaufort, NC. She left her career as a nutritionist in 2003 to follow her lifelong dream of art and has never looked back. The display case is featuring the biological artifacts of November's favorite bird, the turkey. Dr. Charles Manooch, III has been a turkey hunter turned turkey whisperer and is now an avid nature observer. He enjoys spending time watching the majestic animals through his scope. He worked as a fisheries scientist and professional conservationist from Morehead City. Dr. Manooch was a researcher who worked at the NOAA Laboratory in Beaufort. He has written many books about his life growing up in North Carolina that can be found here at the library. The shelf holds three tail feathers, a string of talons, and two turkey beards. The original acrylic painting of turkeys is by Duane Raver, Jr., a talented artist with a scientist's eye for detail. He is very detailed in his paintings, counting feather patterns and making sure everything, even the setting, is authentic. Often, his paintings are more accurate than photographs. Raver's work can be seen here at the library in the 1984 book *Fisherman's Guide: Fishes of the Southeastern United States*, written by Dr. Charles S. Manooch, III. It contains 150 original color illustrations created by Mr. Raver.

**Pine Knoll Shores:** During the month of November, The Art Gallery of the Bogue Banks Public Library will feature the large colorful paintings of Michelle Johnson Fairchild. Michelle Johnson Fairchild paints to capture moments in time. Whether that moment be a walk along the dunes with only the sound of the tide, the happy go-lucky spirit of a beloved pet, or the expression that define an iconic celebrity's passion for music or film, Fairchild has an uncanny ability to use paint and canvas to evoke a strong emotional response.

Fairchild has an artist's heart, hands and love for COLOR! A portrait artist, published illustrator, and painter with a passion for life, she is also a survivor of domestic violence. Following her entire life's work as an artist, over 100 paintings, being destroyed in an act of violence, she began using her art and story to educate and empower victims and she has spoken nationally about her experience. The hope found in her survivor's story has been instrumental in helping others escape violent relationships and find healing through artwork. After resigning from a 23-year career of teaching high school art, Michelle has devoted the last year and a half to honing her craft and painting daily. She and her family have called the Crystal Coast home for a little over a year and have recently opened a gallery and working studio in downtown Morehead City called Gypsybee Studios and Gallery.
