Questions about using NC Famous

How do I find these books? Use the call number to find the book in the library. In this bibliography, the call number is placed before the book title. For example:

B MURROW Edward R. Murrow, young newscaster / by Myers, Hortense
(the call number is in **bold** type)

The call number is located on the spine of each book.

What does “B “ mean? We use the letter “B” to let you know that the book is a Biography, or a book about someone’s life. So, you would find the Biography of Andrew Johnson under the call number “B JOHNSON >”

What does “JB” mean? We use the letters “J” and “B” to let you know that the book is a Juvenile Biography and can be found in the Juvenile section of the library.

How can I get a book from a “CPC Regional Location?” Books on this bibliography that are noted as “@ other CPC Regional Locations” can be found through the library’s catalog. Once you find a book you would like to see, you can use your library card to *request* the book and have it sent to your library.
